What do we fund?

Contribution of up to £6,000 to fund a Level 5 or higher teaching qualification

- Postgraduate Certificate of Education (PGCE L7)
- Professional Certificate of Education (Prof. Cert L6)
- Diploma in Education and Training/Certificate of Education L5 (In Science, Engineering and Technology (SET) subjects)

Teaching qualification can be delivered in-house or via a third party (using face to face, blended or online delivery)

Grant of £5,400 per trainee to contribute towards

- industry insight placement
- recruitment costs
- coaching and mentoring of the trainee teachers
- staff replacement costs to cover trainee attendance at industry placement and Technical Knowledge Skills Enhancement (TKSE) events

Practitioner Informed Practice Research Projects (PIP)

- Opportunity for trainees to lead a Practitioner Improvement Project (PIP), testing and developing effective STEM teaching
- £1,000 grant available (subject to an application process)

Benefits

- Develops trainees who are ready to teach the new T-Levels, apprenticeships and wider SET study programmes
- Supports trainees via a national peer support programme
- Opportunity to spend three days in industry, FE or HE settings to identify and better understand current industry practice and career progression pathways..
- Creates trainees with excellent soft skills including empathy, critical thinking and team-working

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
